2024 NWCA Scholarship Application Guidelines

- 1. Children, stepchildren, grandchildren, and children under the legal guardianship of current Nebraska Weed Control Superintendents are eligible to apply for a NWCA scholarship.
- 2. Applicants must be seniors attending an accredited Nebraska High School.
- 3. The scholarship may be used for any costs associated with continuing education including, but not limited to, tuition, books, fees, room and board. The scholarship applies to the 2024-25 academic year. The scholarship may not be used for summer sessions or online-only courses.
- 4. Applications must be postmarked on or before March 10, 2024. Applications postmarked after March 10, 2024 will not be considered. Scholarship recipients will be notified on or before April 15, 2024.
- 5. Recipients must attend a post-high school educational institution.
- 6. Applicants must submit an essay entitled "The Importance of County Weed Departments in Nebraska".
- 7. Applicants must sign the application and waiver authorizing inquiry into enrollment status.
- 8. The scholarship selection committee may consider need, merit, achievements, references, and other criteria deemed appropriate. Decisions of the scholarship selection committee are final.
- 9. Two scholarships in the amount of \$500 will be awarded. Scholarship checks will be awarded to recipients upon submission of proof of enrollment.
